### Schools Pets and Animal Care — Ms Brown (Science)

I am delighted to report that our chicken shed and run has been constructed and will soon be populated with 2 bantam hens that are pets from my own family farm.

As well as the gerbils and fish in the classroom, we now have Trevor the Tortoise and Eddie & Ernie the rabbits to get to know. Please be reassured that only students who wish to pet the animals will do so.

This year I am running a new course which is a BTEC in Animal Care – it's a 2-year course comprised of internal and external assessments and is being offered to year IO in the first instance and then year 9 students if there is space. The course will run all day on a Monday throughout the school year and students will work with all of the animals in the school as well as having some offsite trips and visits to increase their understanding of animals and their behaviour.

It is my intention to bring in my own dog-Plum, a springer spaniel to enhance the experience for our boys.
