Dear Parents & Carers, October 2023

Thanks for all your support this half term. We have had a busy half term! Our students have had a fantastic start back to school and have been working hard. We are delighted with our new pupils and our relationships with them are gathering positive momentum, although it takes time to build trust, rapport and relationships, we are as confident as always of their incremental happiness here.

We have also been lucky enough to have 4 new members of teaching staff join us this term; Mr. Norton is the new teacher of one of our Key Stage 3 classes, Mr. Clotworthy is a new Key Stage 4 teacher, Ms. Ball is teaching PSHE across the school and Mr. Halse is our new PE teacher for the whole school. We also had some movement in staff following the retirement of Mrs. Burnard; Miss. Aksoy moved to teaching the Upper KS2 boys in the Primary Unit and we currently have Rosie working in reception following our usual Receptionist starting her maternity leave. They are all doing an amazing job.

Staff have been working behind the scenes to review the curriculum across the school and we are currently building 'Pathways' for each of our students to tailor their learning to their individual needs and abilities. We will share more about this with you after half term and the website will be updated as soon as this work has been completed. Our main this year is about improving upon what the children learn, why we think it's important and best to deliver it to them, so that they take the relevance of their learning into adult-hood.

Key Stage 2 have had quite a few new students this year and they are finding their feet and settling into their new school. There have been learning trips to Haven banks for our Upper Key Stage 2 students and swimming sessions have been happening weekly for them also. Once the Lower Key Stage 2 students are settled, we will work on getting them out on some trips to support their learning and for rewards.

In Maths across the school we have been learning about number and Place Value. After the half term break, we will be learning about Fractions in various formats and at varying levels.

'Magic & Mystery' and 'Crime and Punishment'. After half term, in English, we will be learning about 'Dreams and Desires' in Lower Key Stage 2 and 'Power vs Principles' in Upper Key Stage 2. In Key Stage 3, we will read 'The Boy in the Striped Pyjamas' and 'Friend or Foe'. We will continue this theme in Key Stage 3 through our topic work where we will be learning about elements of WWII and are hoping to get out to Tiverton Museum.
